General information regarding the course may be found in *The Student Handbook*. More specifically, this course is project- and writing-oriented, but constantly reviews acquired concepts from the previous four years in the *langue seconde* course. Emphasis is put on written exercises, expressive and argumentative writing, and oral formal and informal interaction. Hence, effort and participation are the key to success. The language of exchange in class must always be “la langue de Molière”, in order to create a stimulating and learning French environment.

### Cultural outing and activity

This year, the secondary 5 class of «Français, Langue seconde, programme enrichi» will attend the representation of the following plays: *Temps Zéro* by Marc-André Brunet on November 29<sup>th</sup> at Le Théâtre Denise-Pelletier. ***Participation to those cultural outings is mandatory*** as it is part of the academic activities required for the course.

Homework policy +/- 20 minutes after each class

Can be: reading, studying, writing, reading French newspapers and/or magazines, researching for projects, preparing for oral presentations, etc.

### Grading

- Term 1 and 2 (20% each) grades will be taken into account when applying to Cegeps.
- Term 3 is worth 60% of the total mark for the year. Term work and June exam each account for 50% of the final grade.
- The June exam will include a reading and a writing component.
- Competencies breakdown: Oral 33%, Reading 34%, Writing 33%.
