CEGEP Application Process for Fall 2016

There are three (3) types of application systems:

Service Regional Admission du Montreal Metropolitain Application (SRAM)

Participating English CEGEPS: Vanier and John Abbott

Cost: \$30 (Visa / MasterCard)

Deadline: March 1st, 2017 (11:59 p.m.)

Important tips:

- Read instructions.
- Make sure to confirm your application request and print your transaction number. The Transaction number will allow applicants to check the status of their application in the SRAM website.
- SRAM allows you to complete a simulation application before completing the application.
- Check if you must send the CEGEP any additional documentation.

Process:

- The SRAM application allows you to choose **a single program in a single SRAM-affiliated Cégep per round**. If you are refused, you can then apply to the next round for that semester without putting together a new application or paying any additional fees.
- Regardless of which round you have been admitted, you begin in fall of the next school year.
 - The deadline to apply for **round 1** is **March 1st**. Students will find out if they have been admitted by **April 6th**.
 - If the student is not accepted, they may re-apply for round 2. The deadline for **round 2** is **April 20th**. Students will find by **May 7th** if they have been accepted.
 - If the student is not accepted, they may re-apply for round 3. The deadline for **round 3** is **May 25th**.

Common Application System (CAS)

Participating English CEGEPS: Dawson and Champlain: Saint-Lambert

Cost: \$30 (Visa / MasterCard)

Deadline: March 1st, 2017 (11:59 p.m.)

Important tips:

- Read and follow instructions carefully.
- You must consult individual College publications or websites for program descriptions and pre-requisites.
- You must complete only **ONE** application form. Separate applications to both Colleges in the Common Application System will **not** be considered.
- You must enclose all documents and fees as required. The first-choice College must receive all documents and payment by the March 1st deadline.
- Check if you must send the CEGEP any additional documentation.

Process:

- The CAS allows you to indicate a first and second choice for their CEGEP program.
- You may choose:
 - A same program at two different colleges
 - Two different programs at the same College**
 - Two different programs at two different Colleges

**It is highly recommended that students select their first and second choice programs at the same College. The Colleges have recommended this strategy due to the highly competitive nature of Anglophone CEGEP admissions.

Private Institutions

Marianopolis College, LaSalle College, Centennial College, and O'Sullivan College etc. have their own application systems accessible through **their** own websites.

Marianopolis College

Cost: \$50 (Visa / MasterCard)

Deadline: March 1st, 2017 (11:59 p.m.)

Tuition: \$5,130 per year

Important tips:

- Read and follow instructions carefully.
- Consult the Marianopolis College website for entrance and program pre-requisites.
- Enclose all documents and fees as required. Marianopolis must receive all documents and payment by the March 1st deadline.
- After you submitted your application, you must write down the seven-digit student number they will assign. This will allow you to check the status of their application.

Process:

- Applicants can choose a first-choice and a second-choice program at Marianopolis College.
