


Flowchart for people with COVID-19 symptoms

¹ A person who had COVID-19 after December 20, 2021 is considered immune for a period of 60 days. If such a person presents symptoms, the [protocol in effect before the pandemic](#) applies.

² **Exception:** If the symptoms are due to an illness other than COVID-19, a medical note can be accepted (equivalent to "negative result").

³ The date of onset of symptoms (DOS) is day 0 (ex.: if the DOS is February 1st, a 5-day isolation period is from February 1st to 6th, inclusively).

⁴ The isolation period for a child under the age of 12 years is for a maximum of 10 days. If the child tests positive on or after day 5, they must wait 24 hours before doing another test. If the child does not have access to a rapid test OR if a special needs child is unable to undergo rapid testing, their isolation period can be lifted after 10 days.
